※ Maximum availability ratio was 58.9% (as of the end of March, 2013)

Start your disaster-prevention action on time even without receiving notification!

Think in advance what to do in an emergency, and try to act accordingly during the drill on **Sep. 5th (Thu)!**

Protect yourself first and foremost when an earthquake has occurred.

When you feel a tremor/hear an emergency earthquake alert:

- Take cover under a table indoors.
- Watch for the danger of collapsing block walls or falling objects outdoors.



While driving:

When you feel a tremor/hear an emergency earthquake alert:

- Do not read or send text messages even if you hear your cell phone ringing.
- Do not reduce speed abruptly. (No sudden braking)
- Turn on your hazards.



When the quake has subsided:

- Pull off to the left side of the road.
- Check things out calmly.
- Do not blindly rush out of your car.

※Do not actually simulate the above on the drill day, but observe traffic rules.

When the quake has subsided:

- Turn off the stove or put out the fire immediately.
- Open the front door to secure a means for escape, and act calmly in fleeing from your place.
- Watch out for fallen objects such as tiles and glass.
- Call out to your neighbors, if possible, for evacuation.
- Walk to safety, with a minimum of baggage.
- In a low land area expected to be flooded,
 - flee from possible tsunamis to higher ground or the third or higher floor of a reinforced concrete building
 - never return to where you were until the tsunami warning or advisory is lifted.



Routine preparations can save your life

Routine preparations can reduce damage

It is important to be always prepared for an emergency so as to take action promptly and calmly.

- **Have an emergency survival kit on hand.**
Pack your emergency bag with survival kit items, such as food, drinking water, medicines, a radio, a flashlight, valuables, etc. to take with you right away anytime.
- ※ Be careful not to make it too heavy to carry.
- Prepare emergency supplies such as food, drinking water, a portable gas stove, spare batteries, etc., necessary for surviving about three days after disaster, assuming that water supply, gas, and electricity services are not available.
- Make your home a safer place.
 - Keep furniture and large electrical appliances fixed with anchorages.
 - Attach anti-shatter films to glass windows.
- Reinforce your house against earthquakes.
- Check for your evacuation shelter and escape route.
- Determine a contact method and meeting place in an emergency.

In the disaster training, only the cell phone application is available. Install Disaster Flashnews to receive earthquake, heavy rain, or tsunami news by pushing "notification" as soon as possible.



Sign up for membership of Osaka Disaster Prevention Information distribution network.

Members will receive text messages or e-mails about weather/earthquake/tsunami information, evacuation advisories or orders, or other urgent messages in an emergency.
