


1 Tanigawa

We provide traditional Japanese banquet services. Food is outsourced to restaurants in Osaka that serve *kaiseki*, *udon*, *takoyaki*, *okonomiyaki*, *oden* and other cuisine. We can arrange for *geishas* and *maikos* to entertain at banquets. (Banquets can be held at Tanigawa or elsewhere.)

Tanigawa is a high-end establishment with a long list of loyal patrons. Our patrons expect and receive nothing less than the high-quality service and hospitality that are traditional to Japan. Every party is given a private room and never has to share it with other patrons. Rooms with sunken tables can seat up to 6 persons. Prayer rooms can be prepared separately for Islamic patrons. Vegetarian, halal, gluten-free and other food preferences can be accommodated for *kaiseki* requests, therefore consult with us in advance. Popular foods in Osaka like *udon*, *okonomiyaki* and *takoyaki* can be served in the comfort of one's private room. *Geishas* and *maikos* can be arranged to entertain patrons with traditional Japanese dancing, music and games.
